Used as a thickening agent, foam stabilizer, fat liquor and essence solubilizer. It is used in the formulation of liquid detergents for cleaning. It has the advantage of less use of salt in increasing viscosity, thus decreasing the dryness caused by it. Excellent foam stabilizer, providing a rich, dense foam. In formulations, when shielded with sulfonic acid, it acts as a neutralizer, thus facilitating its preparations and formulations.
